Dear Parent/Carer

We have been contacted by the school immunisation team, who would have been coming into the school to undertake the first phase HPV Vaccination programme for Year 8 students in the summer term.

The HPV programme was previously targeted at girls in this age group but evidence has shown this vaccination can also help prevent types of cancer found in boys also and so for the first time the programme is being rolled out to the whole year group.

This is a two-phase programme, with the first injection in Year 8 and the second in Year 9.

Due to the present circumstances the Immunisation team has made the decision to gain permission for your son/daughter to have the vaccination. In due course, they will advise both yourselves and the school as to where the vaccinations will take place.

The team will be contacting you by telephone to complete the necessary paperwork. The nurse will introduce herself and to ensure that you know this is a legitimate call will use the unique reference code IMBHPV to enable you to proceed. If the call is to your mobile it may appear as a private number call, and they will leave a message for you to contact them and will quote the unique reference code for Imberhorne students IMBHPV.

A copy of the form can be found on the school website and trust we can count on your support in assisting the Immunisation team in this rather large undertaking for the students in West Sussex.
