There is a specific email address for this to be returned to so we can then share the work with the form tutors. This is part of us getting to know our new students.



As one of the many things that we will be doing to support your child, we will be sharing our virtual tour with you next Friday 26th June. In addition, between the 22nd June and the 3rd July we will be phoning every Year 6 family whom we have not already had contact with. This is just to introduce ourselves to you and give you an opportunity to ask any questions you have at this stage. We are also more than happy to talk to your child as well during this phone call, whichever you prefer.

We have not yet finalised form groups, this is scheduled for completion in early July. We always endeavour to ensure students are placed with at least one friend and we do take advice from the primary schools. Once this has been completed, our aim is to provide opportunities where Form Tutors can meet their form members virtually in July.

In order to further support your child, Mrs Cook, Head of Year 7, has created an audio book

especially for Year 6 students. This can be access via our website, with new chapters uploaded every Monday, starting next week, 22nd June. The book is "The Boy at the Back of the Class". This is an acclaimed book dealing with inclusion, acceptance, and community. It is about a refugee child and some of the difficulties he faces. Furthermore, Year 6 teachers are aware of this initiative, as we have offered to purchase a copy of the book for primary schools if they have not already got it.
