



Home Learning Plan 2020-2021

Please see the details below of our Home learning Plan, which we will need to put into place if a large group of students, for example a year group, have to isolate at home for two weeks.

- Your son/daughter will need to attend all five lessons in the school day, online, at the usual lesson times
- Teachers will take a register for each lesson – please contact the school in the usual way, if your child is unwell and cannot join the live lessons
- Students will join lessons via Google Meet and will need to log in to their school Google account using their school e-mail address (the six-digit number they use to access school computers followed by @imberhorne.co.uk e.g. 012345@imberhorne.co.uk) and the same password they use to login to computers in school
- Students will receive separate links for each lesson, these will be sent as emails to their school e-mail account. They simply click the link and join
- Typically, teachers will teach parts of the lesson live and will also allow students time to complete tasks. When working independently teachers and students may turn cameras and microphones off. Teachers will almost always start and end the lesson by video link
- We expect them to be in school uniform for all lessons, this should be their school polo shirt and jumper, but may be a PE top, with the school logo on. They will need to turn their cameras on, and will only turn them off if the teacher gives them permission to
- Please ensure the background is suitable and the home environment is free from distractions (where possible)
- All lessons will be recorded and will be available for students to access at a later time

If your son/daughter does not have access to a mobile phone, tablet, laptop or computer, please let us know as soon as possible so that we can help support you.

It would be really helpful if you can take an active role in your son's/daughter's learning by asking them about their day and what work they've done.

Please keep in touch with us and do let us know if you're having any difficulties with remote learning, or if you have any questions please contact the appropriate Head of Year.
