Covid Testing

I am pleased to say that our on-site Covid testing ran very efficiently on Tuesday and Wednesday, a small number of positive cases were detected along with some positive cases detected through home testing either just before or after our school testing. This shows that such systems, although laborious and time-consuming, do make a difference.

As of Thursday, we have 14 Key Stage 3 students isolating, 23 Key Stage 4 students isolating and 13 Sixth Form students isolating. We will clearly continue to track these patterns over the coming weeks. I am pleased to say this infection rate is lower than what we experienced in November as we returned from the half term break.

LFD Test Kits

We really appreciate the support we are getting from families, I know households are undertaking regular LFD testing at home and making sure we know of any positive cases promptly. We are awaiting further deliveries of LFD test kits and hope to be able to distribute these soon. We have a surplus of mass testing kits which would suit families undertaking several LFD tests a week. If any parents or carers would like to have a mass testing kit (containing enough solution for 25 tests in a fortnight) please contact our reception and we can arrange for these to be collected.

Revised Isolation Period

I would also like to advise you that we have received further clarification from the DfE regarding isolation periods. As you are aware this has been reduced from the mandatory 10 days to 7 days providing that an individual has two clear LFD tests on day 6 and 24 hours later on day 7. Once clear individuals may return to school on day 7 (previously we were advised a return would be on day 8).
