Many congratulations to our Year 11 students who have recently achieved their Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award. They completed all three challenge areas and have now been officially 'signed off'. This is a superb achievement and moves our students another step closer to graduating with Distinction this Summer. I was so impressed to hear that our students notched up an impressive **364** hours of volunteering last year.
