Year 9 Volunteering

We are delighted by the success of our Year 9 volunteering days. The whole of Year 9 undertook a day of volunteering in our community, with the vast majority of these placements sourced by parents. For those unable to source a placement we organised our own opportunities. I have received feedback from a few community organisations who have been full of praise for our students, describing them as wonderful ambassadors for the school. Our school-based volunteering was at the Young Epilepsy Centre in Lingfield. Here students helped staff at the centre set up equipment and prepare an area to be developed as a pond. We have a long-standing link with the centre and have supported many initiatives over the years. I am very grateful to parents and carers for your support with this initiative.
