#### **Roadworks and Buses**

Metrobus and West Sussex County Council have advised that due to roadworks at Felbridge from 31.10.22 until 11.11.22 there will be road closures which will affect the following Metrobus services:



#### 624, 643, 281, 291

In the morning all the above services will not turn right out of Crawley Down following the normal route which passes Cuttinglye Road, continuing along the Crawley Down Road past Rowplatt Lane junction and on to Felbridge. The service will instead come into the village, serve the main village, and then return to Sandy Lane turning right to continue to the Dukes Head roundabout and then right at the roundabout following the A264 to Felbridge. The journey will reverse in the afternoon.

Students who normally board services at Cuttinglye Road and further along the Crawley Down Road do not have any public transport for the duration of the roadworks unless they are taken into Crawley Down village and are collected from the village.
