I have particularly enjoyed visiting lessons and activities this week. The Senior Leadership Team and Science Leaders have been undertaking a review of our work in Science, and so I have had the pleasure and privilege of visiting a broad range of lessons over the last three days. During my visits I watched one group of Year 11 students create and test an electric motor, another group have fun with the limits of proportionality and Year 12 students build on their (already considerable) knowledge of covalent bonding.

Each subject had a particular aspect of post-16 learning to share, and students were extremely enthusiastic about these new experiences throughout the day. ## Children in Need – Total Money Raised

Thank you to all students, staff and parents/carers who worked so hard to support our Children in Need activities last Friday. The total amount raised was £2,800. What a terrific team effort!

### **Celebration of Achievement**

We are delighted to share the total number of achievement points that our students have been awarded so far this year. These are the points our students have earned for 'Being Ready, Having Pride and Showing Respect'. It is wonderful to see how many of our students make the extra effort in their work and personal conduct each day. A total of 72,094 achievement points have been awarded this term, including 40,979 merits, 5,592 praise emails and 2,515 Imberstar nominations. Year 7 are leading the way with the most merits, and Year 10 are topping the leader board for praise emails and achievement points overall.

Next Wednesday we are holding a celebration event for Year 7, where we will share our first round of certificates. 68 students have achieved their silver level already for 100+ points.

Finally, our praise emails are once again reaching the email inboxes of students and parents/carers when they are awarded by staff. Although the points have been added to student point totals, the actual email has not been triggered through Bromcom since our switch to that system. Apologies for the inconvenience this has caused, but please keep your eye out now for the praise emails and Monday celebration round up emails (the first of which should reach your inbox on Monday 28 November).
