In order to connect to Remote Access using the app (and these instructions) your iPad/iPod/iPhone needs to be running iOS or iPadOS 13 or above. You can check this by opening "Settings" then, tapping "General", and "About" – "Software version" needs to be at least 13.

- 1) Download "Microsoft Remote Desktop" from the Apple App Store. If you're not sure how to do this, we've put some instructions on the last page of this document.
- 2) Once it has installed, run it the button is called "RD Client":

7) By default your device screen works like a giant touch pad on a laptop – moving your finger around will move the mouse pointer and tapping the screen clicks. This makes it easier to click on things on screen that appear small on a mobile device.
