Early Applicants

[Oxbridge, medics, vets, dentists]

School Application Deadline: Monday 23rd September 2019

UCAS Deadline: Tuesday 15th October 2019

Admission Tests: Wednesday 30th October 2019 (in half term!)

All other students

School Application Deadline: Wednesday 13th November 2019

UCAS Deadline: Wednesday 15th January 2020

Where we are now...

- ▶ Personal Statement review by tutors (ongoing)
- ▶ UCAS application booklets issued next Wednesday

This is the start of the application process

The UCAS application process

What the applicant does...

- Writes a personal statement,
- Completes an online application,
- Pays
 - £13 for a single course
 - £24 for more than one course (maximum of 5 course choices)

What the school does...

- Supports the personal statement process,
- Provides a reference,
- Predicts applicant A level grades,
- Checks the application and sends it to UCAS.

UCAS 2019

95 students applied

- 64 Achieved their firm choice of university
(16 received an unconditional offer)
- 6 Achieved their insurance choice of university
- 2 Accepted a revised offer
- 10 Received an offer through clearing
- 13 Withdrew

3 are reading medicine or veterinary science

20 are going to Russell Group universities
