



Students can only choose one PE course (Dance, PE or Sport BTEC). Support Option & Construction are for recommended students only.





GCSE RE

The core curriculum gives all students 1 hour per fortnight of RE and 3 hours per fortnight of core PE.

You can transfer 1 hour of core PE to RE instead – then you will have 1 lesson per week for RE and follow a GCSE RE course. Of course, your PE will drop to 1 lesson per week as a result.



Twilight Courses

After school classes running from 3pm to 5pm.

Triple Science is for students wanting to take separate GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Students will be taught in the same groups for science during the normal school day and in the twilight.

Italian allowing students to study an additional language.

These courses require a 2 year commitment & we recommend you only choose one twilight.

Good reasons for choosing subjects

What subjects am I good at?

Avoid making choices based on ...

Who my teachers are. You will have a lot of new teachers at Key Stage 4.

What my friends are choosing. You could be in classes with anyone from your year group.





Are you expected to continue with your foreign language?

Are you Flight Path 3 or 4 for your language? We expect you will continue your language to GCSE.

Are you Flight Path 1 or 2 for your language? You don't have to continue with your language – but you can choose it if you want.

Maybe you don't study a language now in Year 9. Then you won't choose one for GCSE.





How many free option choices will you have?

Are you Flight Path 3 or 4 for your language?
