


Attendance

- Funding regulations dictate that a student MUST be withdrawn from their course of study if they are absent for 20 consecutive school days. The Education and Skills Funding Agency does not distinguish between authorized and unauthorized absence for this purpose.

Withdrawal of Examination Entry Fees

All students enrolled to complete examinations or coursework between the ages of 16-19 at Imberhorne Sixth Form will be entered for their exams, the school funds the exams in the first instance. However, the school reserves the right to withdraw this payment for all or individual subjects the student is entered for on the grounds of attendance. Our ability to do so is outlined clearly in the Funding guidance for young people 2023 to 2024 from the ESFA (education and skills funding agency) section 2.
